Landscape Plant Identification

Ground Covers

Ajuga – *Ajuga reptans*



- AKA: Carpet bugle
- Leaf: opp, purple/green, hairy-coarse texture; serrated close to tip
- Flower: small purple
- Stem: purple, rhizomes
- Habit: very low growing but doesn't appear viney

Purple leaf wintercreeper – *Euonymus fortunei* 'coloratus'



- Leaf: opp, serrated leaves, some variegated white, defined pin. venation
- Flower:
- Fruit: N/A
- Stem: viney
- Habit: low lying "creeper" used to cover and prevent erosion

Purple leaf wintercreeper – con't



- Variegated version (white outlines)



English Ivy – *Hedera helix*



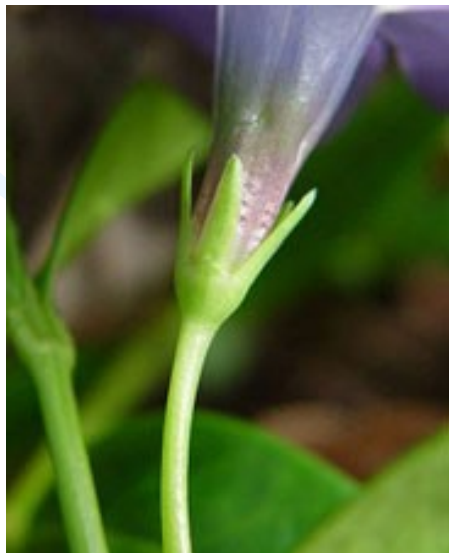
- Leaf: very defined palmate venation, 3-5 lobed alt leaf,
- Flower: yellow
- Fruit: N/A
- Stem: alt. buds
- Habit: low lying and climbing vines

Pachysandra - *Pachysandra*



- AKA: Spurge (not the weed)
- Leaf: dk green, glossy, whorled leaf arrgmt, upper leaf margin is mod. serrated
- Flower: sm white
- Habit: grows more upright than most grd covers

Periwinkle – *Vinca minor*



- Leaf: waxy, opposite, oval leaves; prominent, pinnate venation; very viney
- Flower: 5 petals, bluish-purple
- Habit: low lying and viney

Periwinkle – con't



- Twig: viney, opp scars and buds
