EXAMPLES OF NHS LEADERSHIP *This a sample not an exhaustive list

<u>Leadership</u>: defined as leading, organizing, teaching, or directing a group of one's peers whether formally (with a title) or informally. The leadership role must be clearly defined as on-going (continuous), sustained(continuing for an extended period w/o interruption) and significant(sufficiently important).

- 1. Class/Club Officers
- 2. Sports team captains
- 3. Band section/squad leader
- 4. Training people at a job
- 5. Mentor
- 6. Teaching at a camp, in a classroom, etc. (Camp Counselor)
- 7. Organizing/Leading tasks for a group (Stark Hunger Task Force, St. Baldrick's, etc.)
- 8. Student Director of a play
- 9. Organizing community meetings for a club or organization
- 10. Leadership Council or Board (be sure to describe what you individually lead)
- 11. Boy Scout leader of a major project such as Eagle Scout, etc.
- 12. Youth Group leader
- 13. Develop/Lead Non-profit
- 14. Organizing/Leading fundraisers or other activities for non-profits
- 15. Teaching/leading lessons in a Sunday school class, at a camp, etc.
- 16. Teen Ambassador

*Again, whatever the leadership, it must be "amongst one's peers".
