The Byzantine emperor told Peter the Hermit and his army to wait for the European knights, Peter the Hermit's army refused and attacked the Turks and got badly defeated.

-The European knights got to Constantinople and treated the Byzantines badly killing and looting (taking all resources).

- -The European knights and Peter the Hermit's army joined and captured the holy city of Jerusalem from the Seljuk Turks

- -Increased trade and made the use of money more common.
