1. When logged into the computer open Filemaker Pro. In most cases you should see a Filemaker Pro Icon in the dock. If you do not see an icon in the dock look for "Filemaker Pro" under "Applications" in the sidebar of a finder window. If it is not available under Applications then Filemaker is not installed on that Mac. Locate a Computer on which it is installed or create a tech request
