"The Only Way to Have a Cow" by Bill McKibben, "In Praise of Fast Food" by Rachel Laudan and "We Paved Paradise" by Katharine Mieszkowski are all unique looks into their topics and strong examples of **evaluation arguments**.

Your first essay is an evaluation argument about an aspect of culture – a media experience. (Faigley *Writing* text book page 325)

- 1. Read the Essay 1 Media experience assignment sheet. Write the assignment main goal out in your own words.
- 2. Define MEDIA don't just give examples try to define MEDIA
- 3. Now, give examples of MEDIA
- 4. Define GUILTY PLEASURE
- 5. Now, give examples of GUILTY PLEASURES don't have to be media related
- 6. What are TWO or THREE guilty pleasures you participate in that would work for the media essay evaluation argument?
- 7. How does your media experience fit the criteria of guilty pleasure?
- 8. How is your media experience "a waste or time, stupid, immoral or offensive?"
- 9. What one media experience are you leaning toward writing about? (Reference the assignment sheet. Is your experience unique? Is your experience a guilty pleasure? This is a brainstorming day you can change your mind later.)
- 10. What will be some **specific criteria** you will have to make sure to include in your Essay 1 that you will then evaluate? (Use page 325 to help you.)
- 11. Look at McKibben's essay on page 327. There is a flow chart about how the essay is organized. In what ways would this essay and the flow chart be an effective model for your evaluation argument about your media experience?
- 12. What specific groups of people will think your media experience is a waste of time, stupid, immoral or offensive? (the naysayers)
- 13. How will you concede (make a concession) about how you do agree that your media experience is sometimes a waste or time, stupid, immoral or offensive?

ADVICE – Chapter 11, pages 324-325, are key. You are evaluating an experience of **CULTURE**. Make sure you have read the essays in the chapter.
