**Instructions and Rules**

Any Ohio student in 1<sup>st</sup>-6th grade is eligible to enter. **Only one poster per grade may be sent to represent Lake Cable!** **Poster entries must illustrate the theme of Ohio severe weather safety and include a written safety message.** The purpose of the poster contest is to ENGAGE Ohio's youth in learning the importance of severe weather safety and to demonstrate through illustrations, actions they can take before, during and after severe weather events to protect themselves and others. **Posters must cover one of these categories: tornadoes, flooding, thunder and lightning storms, winter storms or extreme heat (heat waves).**

Artwork must be original and illustrated by individual students (no teamwork, please). Computer/digitally generated artwork and text can be used. Crayons, markers, pencils, paints and/or stencils can be used. **No photographs, copyright-protected material, or clippings from magazines, newspapers or books may be used.** Posters can be either landscape or portrait. Poster size cannot exceed 11" x 17" paper.

Posters will be judged on originality, effort and technical correctness. All winning posters from the previous school year can be viewed at the following website: [www.weathersafety.ohio.gov](http://www.weathersafety.ohio.gov) under "Just for Kids." All entered posters become property of the National Weather Service and the Ohio Committee for Severe Weather Awareness.

All regional winners (one per each of the five regions, per grade level) and their parents or guardians will receive two entry passes for the day at the Ohio State Fair on August 3, 2019. The awards ceremony will be held that day and all regional winners will receive several prizes and certificates.
