

# ***Cedar Point Trip - Class of 2028***



Dear 8th Grade Students and Parents:

We are excited for 8th grade students to be able to celebrate their middle school years with a Class of 2028 Field Trip to Cedar Point, Sandusky Ohio. This year the trip will be on: **Thursday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>**. We will be departing from JMMS @ 7:15AM by chartered busses and will be returning that evening at approximately 9:00-9:30PM.

**Students should be at the school between 6:45-7:00. Bus boarding will begin @ 7:00AM, with a departure time of 7:15AM. Students should enter doors 20E to the Purple Gym.**

Students may choose your partner to sit with on the bus (male with male & female with female).

**Select carefully – no change in bus buddy permitted.**

**Cost of the trip is \$90.00 which includes park admission and charter bus transportation. If your child has a season pass to Cedar Point, the cost of the trip will be \$ 50.00 to cover the transportation cost. \* Jackson Memorial Middle School or PATT will not be responsible for lost or stolen passes.**

# *Cedar Point Trip*

## *Class of 2028 Rules and Guidelines*



**Departure** – We will pull out at 7:15 am sharp. Be at JMMS no later than 6:45 am. Students dropped off on East side of building entering doors 20E.

**Leaving Cedar Point** – You must report to your chaperone at your designated spot no later than 7:15 pm.

**Arrival back at JMMS** – We are planning on arriving back at JMMS at 9:30pm. Students should be picked up at the same location they were dropped off in the morning.

**Refunds** – Tickets and transportation are purchased in advance. There will be no refunds available. If a student is unable to attend after permission slips and money have been turned in, please make sure to alert Mr. Fisher so adjustments can be made to the participant list. **Exclusion from participation due to behavior, a student changing their mind, or missing the bus will not result in a refund.**

**Food & Drink(On Bus)** – You will be permitted to eat and drink on the buses. Drinks must be in a resealable bottle and contain no dairy products. Reminder Starbucks is not resealable. NO GLASS bottles. You are responsible for cleaning up your seat upon return. We will **NOT** be stopping on the way home to eat.

**Food & Drink(In Cedar Point)** – Each student is responsible to bring extra money to purchase lunch and refreshments. Please note that Cedar Point is a cashless park. If you send cash with your child, there will be kiosks through the park. Please see the link for additional information for Cedar Point.

**Check-In** – Each student is required to check in with Mr. Fisher/Mr. Waltman/Mr. Harvey between 1:00-3:00pm. They will be located across from the Coasters Drive-In Diner the entire day. If you have any problems during the day, you can find an adult at the Coasters Drive-I Diner.

**Cellphones** – are permitted. Please follow school policy. We are not responsible for lost or stolen electronics.

**Personal Property** – You are responsible for all your own personal property. There are lockers that you can **rent** at the main gate. Bring change. **DO NOT SHARE LOCKERS!**

**Cedar Point Shores Water Park** – is off limits! You must remain in the main park.

**Dress** – Remember: the park is at least 10 degrees colder than the temperature in Canton. Dress appropriate.

**Bus Buddies** – You are required to sit with your bus buddy on the way to and from Cedar Point. You are not required to spend the day with each other.

**Medication** – Our clinic staff will pull meds from the clinic and give to Mr. Fisher. Kids needing medicine will come see him throughout the day at Coaster's Drive-In. All medicine has to go through us. Kids are not responsible for their own meds.

**Remember** – This is a school related activity. All rules that apply at JMMS will apply at Cedar Point.

**Prohibited Items** – The following items are prohibited on the bus: dairy products, perfume, bug spray, and nail polish.
